In follow-up to Governor Baker's most recent announcement, as of now, Mother Caroline Academy will remain closed for the next three weeks and will reopen on April 7, 2020.

We will continue to stay in communication with families with the latest up-to-date information.

Please continue to check your email, Jupiter, our MCA Facebook page and MCA Instagram for the most up-to-date information. Families, please note that students should not come to the building as there will not be any access to Mother Caroline Academy throughout the entirety of this closure.

The MCA faculty has prepared academic work for your child to complete while we go through this unprecedented health issue. Last Friday, your student was given assignments, in all subject areas, in the form of packets and textbooks.

Please know that your students' teachers are available, by email, to answer any questions that you may have during this extended school closure. Monday - Friday teachers will be responding to student and family emails within a 24 hour period. Emails sent from students and families on Saturdays and Sundays will be answered within 48 hours.

Our teachers want to be able to help you support your students learning while we work through this challenging situation. We know that not all students have access to technology so teachers will be reaching out with assignments and updates via email and any other platforms that students currently use.
